

# Resurrection Eggs Folder Learning

## Devotional for Teachers: Application

**Bible:** Matt., Mark, and John

**Lesson:** Resurrection Eggs:

**Important Point:** Telling others the resurrection story.

### Direction:

**1. Print and cutout on the dotted line:** Egg cutting Pattern, the Egg Labels, and numbers.

### 2. Folder:

- a) fold one half of the file folder in towards the middle (crease in half)
- b) Draw a line (where the folded side of the folder meets the unfolded side) and cut on the line. (Now the folder is folded into thirds long ways.)
- c) Set and trace the egg pattern on the outside of the folder at the fold line. Don't worry which flap, because you will be doing this to both sides.
- d) Mark the where the dashed lines will be and cutout the eggs
- e) Cut on the dashed lines.

### 3. Glue:

- a) Glue the numbers to the outside of the flaps of each egg
- b) Fold the labels at the egg fold lines on the carton. Glue the Egg Labels to the inside of the egg carton only on the base, not on the flap. Be sure the picture is on the inside base of the egg carton and verse is on the flap. Also be certain the verses are at the correction number. Check the Egg Label sheet.

**4. Egg Carton Lid:** Fold down a 1/2 inch of the top end of the remaining piece of manila folder. Lay it end to end with the egg carton base with the overlap being only the folded part. (The folded part should be in back of the egg carton.) Staple the lid and back of the carton together. Be sure not to staple the eggs shut. The lid should be able to close over the eggs. You can secure the carton closed with a wing fastener on the top of the carton at the bottom and one fastener on the bottom of the carton at the bottom. Connect them with a 3 inch piece of thin string. Tie one end to the bottom with a knot and wrap the other end around the top wing fastener. It is always easier to attach the wing fasteners if you make a starter whole with a pen tip. Glue the Resurrection Eggs sign of the top of the egg carton.

**5. Options Touch and Feel Resurrection Eggs:** On the back of the egg flap of each numbered egg you can put a Touch and Feel sensory square that relates to the

object of that egg. Just cutout an 1 inch by 1 inch square of the recommended material and glue it to the back of the corrected egg.

- 1: brown felt (donkey)
- 2: Tin foil (coin)
- 3: Wax paper (cup)
- 4: Crinkled wax paper (praying hands)
- 5: Foamy paper, brown (leather whip)
- 6: Crinkled tinfoil ( Crown of Thorns)
- 7: Corrugated cardboard with the top layer peeled off (wood cross)
- 8: Ziplock bag piece (dice)
- 9: Wrinkled paper bag (spear)
- 10: Gauze (gauze)
- 11: Sand paper (the rock)
- 12: nothing (Tomb empty)

**Materials:** 1 manila/child , scissors, glue stick, liquid white glue, stapler, 2 wing fasteners/child, a thin 3 inch long string/child and colors of some type

**Touch and Feel:** Tinfoil, wax paper, foamy paper, sand paper, corrugated cardboard, ziplock, felt, paper bag, and gauze

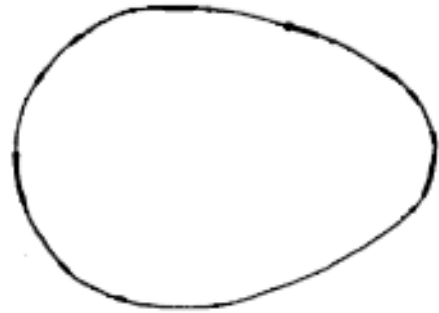
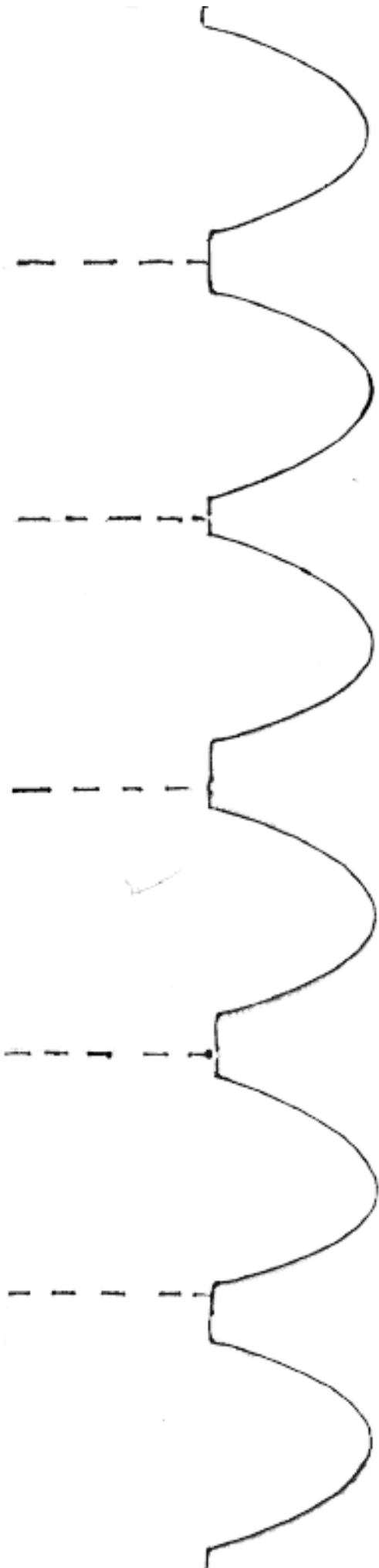
